

Team SVG Named for Commonwealth Games 2014

Kingstown, ST. VINCENT: St. Vincent and the Grenadines (SVG) will be represented across five sports (track and field, swimming, cycling, squash and table tennis) by 26 athletes at the upcoming Commonwealth Games in Glasgow, United Kingdom from July 23 to August 4.

This is the 11th time SVG has participated in the Commonwealth Games with medal wins in 1970 (Bronze for 90kg weightlifting by George Manners), 1974 (Gold for 75kg boxing by Frankie Lucas) and 2010 (Gold for women's 100m by Natasha Mayers) with Jacintha Ballantyne - Chief of Mission and Stephen Joachim - General Team Manager.
