VINCENT: Following December 9, 2015 General Elections in St. Vincent and the Grenadines, which the incumbent United Labour Party (ULP) retained 8 seats and the Opposition New Democratic Party (NDP) 7 seats, the ULP formed the government for a 4th consecutive term.
