Comber, NORTHERN IRELAND: Our beautiful island of St. Vincent was severely damaged by Hurricane Tomas on Saturday October 30th.

In the words of our Prime Minister - Dr the Hon. Ralph E. Gonsalves: "We are looking at millions and millions in damage and is the worst disaster in our living memory".

Although the exact damage is still being assessed, 1200 homes have been destroyed, eight government buildings and the vital agricultural sector, including the important banana industry.
