

Royal Navy Recruitment in St. Vincent

Kingstown, ST. VINCENT: The Royal Navy will be carrying out a recruitment exercise in St. Vincent between November 14 and 28, 2010.

Potential candidates must have an education at the CXC level and be between the ages of 16 and 34.

Persons interested are asked to contact and register with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

Registrations will be based on a first come basis with only the first 250 people registered will be tested.

This is a government lead initiative by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the High Commission in London with the Royal Navy to allow Vincentians to take the initial intake exam at home, cutting down on the expense of travelling to the UK. Without this initiative many Vincentians simply could not afford to travel to take the exam and pursue their dream of being part of the Royal Navy.
