

Consular Corps Donates Books to HM Prison

Belfast, NORTHERN IRELAND: Her Majesty's Prison (HMP) Hydebank Wood, which houses all young male prisoners aged between 17 and 21 years and all female prisoners including young offenders, received a donation of books in different foreign languages for its library.

The books were donated by various Member countries of the Consular Corps/Association of Northern Ireland (CA-NI) to assist HMP library staff in providing a wider selection of titles in different languages, particularly for those Foreign Nationals serving sentences in Northern Ireland.

Dr Christopher Stange – CA-NI Secretariat and Hon. Consul for St. Vincent and the Grenadines to Northern Ireland initiated the book drive with HMP library staff and CA-NI Members, facilitating the collection and delivery on behalf of the Consular Corps to the prison.
